

## Welcome to 2<sup>nd</sup> / 3<sup>rd</sup> Lindfield Scouts

This is the document that you will need to refer back to frequently – so please take your time and read it carefully, before saving it somewhere safe.

Scouting is a volunteer organisation. All uniformed leaders are required to undertake extensive online and practical field training as part of obtaining their Certificate of Adult Leadership.

All leaders have current Working with Children Clearances (WWCC) as well as Police Clearance. They all work full time, have children of their own and shouldn't need to answer the same questions over and over again! Please show your respect for what they do by reading this extensive document carefully. We are more than happy to answer any unanswered questions afterwards.

Parents are integral to the success of the Scout Group and your child's Scouting experience. Parents, Leaders, and all Adult Supporters are on the same team. Scouting is a community organization that continues to exist because of the values and opportunities provided to children, and it needs parents to provide those opportunities. We require all parents to volunteer as part of their child's membership in some way:

- Leaders (uniformed)
- Adult Helpers (non-uniformed)
- Group Committee
- Fundraising / grant support – to keep the cost of Scouting down
- Working Bees

### *What parents need to know*

When referring to Scouts in this document we generally mean all youth members in our group: Joey Scouts, Cub Scouts and Scouts.

Each section meets weekly during public school term times – usually at our scout hall in Beaconsfield Parade, just down the road from KFC and the Post Office.

Joey Scouts: Saturday, 13:45-14:45

Cub Scouts: Monday, 19:00 – 20:30

Scouts: Friday, 19:00 – 21:00

We also try to organize several weekend activities including camps, hikes, fundraisers and social events.

We like to see parents doing as much as they can to encourage their children to participate in these great opportunities as they progress through Scouts. Before signing your child up to Scouts please be mindful you will be required to organise transport for meetings and outdoor activities. You will be asked on occasion to assist with fundraising and help out with Scouting activities and events.

When parents help their Scout Group, the Leaders are free to focus on delivering a great program to our Youth Members. If you want Scouting to be a great experience for your children, please help your Group be a great Group.

## **2nd / 3rd Lindfield Scouts Group is a phone free zone.**

Off and Away – is the slogan we are using in our Scout Group and we expect our youth members and parents to follow this rule. If you are in the scout hall or at a scouting event helping or just watching, please bear this in mind, set a good example and show your children that you are interested in them.

On that note: if you are taking pictures, that is fine, for personal use only. You do not, however, have permission from Scouts Australia to post any pictures of scouts (in uniform) on your personal social media accounts.

### *Uniforms*

Uniform must be worn for all activities, unless otherwise specified by the leaders.

Our Joeys wear a blue polo shirt with brown sleeves, our Cubs and Scouts wear a button up shirt with yellow (cubs) or green (scouts) sleeves.

Once you have decided to stay in scouts (sometime during your trail period) you will be required to purchase a scout shirt. We will provide your scout with a 2<sup>nd</sup> / 3<sup>rd</sup> Lindfield Scarf and Woggle, as well as badges to sew on the uniform. Scouts can earn dozens of badges covering a multitude of interest areas. There's sure to be something that takes your interest.

If you are not sure on the size, ask the leaders who can help you find the right size.

Badges are awarded by the section leaders; they cannot be bought by parents.

### *Adult Helpers*

In our joey section we require at least one parent to be registered as an adult helper and stay with your joey at all scouting events. This can be done on ScoutHub (see under website logins).

You will require a Working with Children Check to register. Organising this can take time, so please get this done as soon as you sign your Joey up for scouts.

# Website Logins

Unfortunately, there are many websites we need to use and they are not linked. You will be asked to create accounts for every scout member in your family on multiple websites.

We heavily recommended that you create an email address for your joeys, cubs or scouts in order to keep track of their different logins.

## 1. **Scout Hub – Scout Membership – Every 6 months!!!**

This is where you go to register as a scout, cub or joey or even as an Adult Helper and Leader. Our youth members (scouts, cubs and joeys) have the options to join up on a trial basis for 6 weeks before they commit and pay membership fees.

The trial membership is free, but necessary if you would like to participate in our activities. Unfortunately, we cannot have children participating in our activities if they not registered – this is a Work, Health and Safety requirement by Scouts Australia.

Once you have completed your online registration you will receive an email from

**Scouts NSW – 2<sup>nd</sup>/3<sup>rd</sup> Lindfield Scout Group**

Check your junk mail if you don't see it come through. You will receive a temporary membership number (starting with 14....) until Scout NSW have completed their background checks. It is not until you receive the proper number that you will be able to log into Scouts Central and Terrain (see further down).

### **TREK 1 & TREK 2**

Every 6 months we all need to renew our membership and pay our fees – this is called Trek 1 (for term 1 & 2) and Trek 2 (for term 3 & 4). You will receive an email when this is due, but generally please look out for it around the 1<sup>st</sup> January and 1<sup>st</sup> July.

### **MULTIPLE FAMILY MEMBERS**

Each family member must be registered and paid individually – this ensures you can check individual details for each person, redeem Active Kids vouchers per person and agree to the terms and conditions.

## ACTIVE KIDS VOUCHERS

If you have an **Active Kids Voucher** and would like to use it on your scout membership – have it ready! You are required to enter your voucher number during registration and prior to payment.

## DISCOUNTS & FINANCIAL SUPPORT

If you are entitled to a discount, e.g. Family Support Fund, or other discount as agreed with your group, please ensure you discuss your registration with your Leader before proceeding.

## 2. Terrain – Badge Work

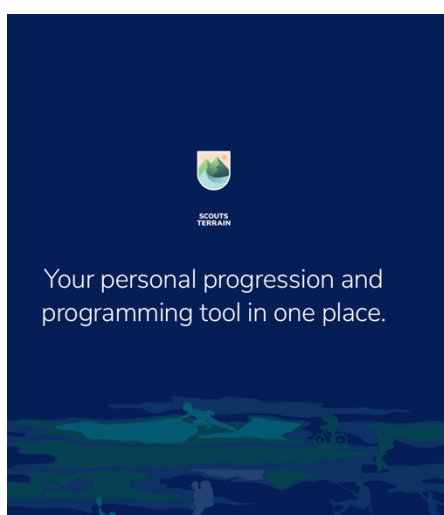

This is where your scout will be able to track their personal progression throughout their entire scouting journey from Joeys all the way to Rovers. If you want a badge, you will need to familiarise yourself with this program.

The first time you enter this website you will need to set up an account – it is NOT linked to your scout number yet and you will need to have access to your email address to complete the set up. Again, we recommended heavily that your scout has their own email address.

Your initial password is your date of birth in exactly this format: yyyy-mm-dd. If this doesn't work, find a leader and they will help you by resetting the password.

Once you have set up your account, feel free to read through:

This will give you some background information that is worth knowing.

Every activity we do in scouts will be logged into Terrain and the youth members will be able to see their progress in their Milestones and Outdoor Adventure Skills areas.

If they want Special Interest Area Badges – the triangle ones – they will need to complete projects at home and log them into Terrain themselves before showing the scout leaders their work.





### 3. Adult Helpers

All adults who interact with our Scout Group in any way will need to be registered as adult helpers. This is FREE. This will cover you for any injuries as well as align with our Kids Safe policies.

In order to become an Adult Helper please follow the steps listed below:

a. Working With Children Check

<https://www.service.nsw.gov.au/transaction/apply-for-a-working-with-children-check>. Please apply as soon as possible as this takes time. Once you have the WWCC you can apply to become a member of scouts.

b. Register as a parent helper with 2<sup>nd</sup> / 3<sup>rd</sup> Lindfield

c. Police Check

Once you have applied to become a member of scouts, you will receive an email from Scouts NSW to accept a police check. Please look out for it and accept it as soon as possible. It often ends up in junk mail.

d. Mandatory Training

At Scouts NSW, we are continuously reviewing our commitment to being a child safe organisation. This includes ensuring all adult members are trained and supported to ensure the safety and protection of our youth members.

To align our child safe learning with Scouts Australia's expectations, it is now a requirement for all members aged over 18 who interact with our youth members, including Adult Helpers, to complete the following two mandatory on-demand training modules within 3 months of member's application for membership being accepted OR prior to an overnight activity, whichever comes first. If the member does not complete the training within the given timeframe, membership with Scouts NSW will be withdrawn and they will no longer be able to attend Scouts NSW events or activities.

## Scouting Preliminary

Scouting Preliminary presents the foundation material that you need to know in order to be able to begin contributing to the delivery of the Scouting program.

It begins with very important safety training followed by a series of modules that will help you to understand why we do what we do it and what makes Scouting so successful.

The quicker you complete these modules the quicker you will become more comfortable in your role. Most people complete them within a few weeks.
